Acts 2:1-13, 38-39, & John 16:5-15

- After Jesus had ascended to heaven, His disciples remained in Jerusalem praying. As they were praying, suddenly there came a sound from heaven, as a rushing mighty wind, and it filled the whole house where they were sitting, tongues of fire appearing over them.
- They were filled with the Holy Spirit, and began to speak in other languages.
- The power of the Holy Spirit at once made the disciples strong and brave.
- The disciples were telling others the wonderful works of God.
- A crowd of Jews, from all over the world, gathered around the disciples because of the strange happenings. Peter, filled with the Holy Spirit, stood up and told the people that this was a fulfillment of a prophecy of Joel, as a result of them killing their own Savior. He said to repent of their sins and be baptized in the name of Jesus. Three thousand people were saved.
