Baggie Hearts

Collect

Bible, one resealable plastic bag for each child, permanent marker, finger paint or ketchup.

Prepare

Use permanent marker to draw a heart shape on the outside of each bag, and put a small amount of finger paint or ketchup in each bag.

Do


Children lay bags on a flat surface and use their fingers to trace over heart shape.



Enrichment Ideas

- 1. Children may trace the letter J for the word "Jesus" or trace their own initials.
- 2. Cut large heart shapes from fingerpaint paper. Pour a small amount of paint (use a variety of colors) onto paper. Invite children to use their hands to paint, making hearts on the paper.






Talk About
