Jesus Comes Alive Again


Matthew 28

A Rolling Stone

After Jesus died, His body was buried in a very special tomb and a big stone was rolled in front of the doorway to close the tomb.

Three days later, Jesus came alive again and left the tomb! When His friends came to the tomb, the stone was rolled away from the door and Jesus was gone! Jesus was not dead any more!

Color the picture of the tomb where Jesus' body was buried. Your teacher will help you attach a brown construction paper stone to the tomb. You can roll away the stone and see the tomb is empty because Jesus is alive!





For the Teacher: For each child, cut a circle about 3%4" in diameter out of brown construction paper. Punch a hole in one side of each circle and attach it to the black dot on the picture of the tomb with a paper fastener. (Do not let the children hold the paper fasteners.) Tape down the prongs of the paper fasteners to avoid injury. Show the children how to roll away the stones to see the empty tombs.


Jesus Comes Alive Again

Jesus Is Alive Sewing Card

After Jesus had been dead for three days, He came alive again! We should be very happy because Jesus is alive.

Color the picture. Your teacher will show you how to use yarn to sew around your circle. You will make a pretty picture that helps you remember to be happy because Jesus is alive.





For the Teacher: Before class, cut out one circle picture for each child, and glue each to an 8-inch circle of poster board. Use a hole punch to punch holes about 2 inches apart around the outside of each circle. Provide lengths of yarn for the children to sew through the holes. (Stiffen the ends of the yarn by wrapping with clear tape.) When the children are finished sewing, tape the ends of the yarn to each picture and attach yarn loops for hanging.
