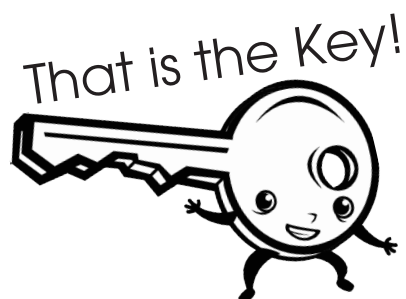
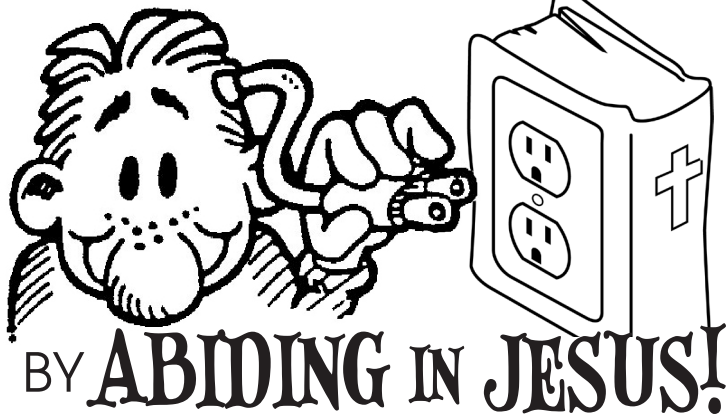
"But the fruit of the Spirit is _____; joy, peace, longsuffering, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control. Against such there is no law."

The fruit of the **SPiRiT** is **LOVE**. After that, the rest of the verse goes on to explain what **LOVE** looks like.

To **ABIDE IN JESUS** means to stay close to Him.
ABIDING and **WALKING IN THE SPIRIT** go together.
