

UNDERSTANDING THE STORY:

Jesus was in the city of Cana.

- There was a man, called a nobleman, from the city of Capernaum who came to Jesus. What was wrong with this man's son?
- What did this man ask/beg Jesus to do for him? Was his son very sick or only a little sick?

Jesus said to the man, "Go your way; your son lives."

- Did this man believe what Jesus said? What did the man do to show that he believed Jesus? Did he obey what Jesus told him to do?
- As the man was going back home, who came to him? What did his servants tell him?
- When Jesus spoke the words, "Your son lives!" what happened to the father's son?
- Did the father believe in Jesus? Who else believed in Jesus?

<u>SIMPLE TRUTHS:</u>

The nobleman went to Jesus when his son was sick.

- When we have a problem, who can we talk to about it? Does Jesus want us to talk to Him? Does Jesus hear us when we talk to Him? Does Jesus care about us?
- This nobleman traveled from one city to another city to talk to Jesus. Do we need to go to a certain place if we want to talk to Jesus? Can we talk to Him wherever we are?

The father believed what Jesus told him and he went home to his son.

- Should we believe and trust what Jesus says? Should we always obey what Jesus tells us to do?
- Does Jesus ever speak to us today? What is one way that God talks to us? (The Bible. The words in the Bible are God's words to us.)
- If the Bible tells us what to do, is that the same as Jesus telling us what to do? (Yes, because the Bible is one of the ways God speaks to us.)
- God wants to do wonderful things in each of our lives. When we obey what He tells us to do, we will see how powerful God is because He will do amazing things as we obey Him.
- Let's pray and ask Jesus to help us obey Him when He tells us to do something. We can also thank Him for loving us the way that He does.

Sometimes Jesus will heal a person when their body is sick, but Jesus ALWAYS wants to take away the sin that is in a person's heart.

 Jesus came to earth to save and rescue people from sin. He wants to give us life that lasts forever with Him in heaven. Have you ever asked Jesus to forgive you of your sins? Would you like to do that now?






